Adirondack Community Action Programs Inc. is looking for individuals who are willing to make a difference in the lives of others. Applications are being accepted for the following positions:

Head Start Program:

Teacher- Ticonderoga and Moriah site. Applicants must possess a Bachelor's Degree or an Associate's Degree in Early Childhood Education or a related field and have a plan of study leading to a Bachelor's Degree with 12 early childhood credits or a Child Development Associate (CDA). Supervisory and early childhood experience preferred. This is a full-time position that follows the school calendar and the rate of pay is \$14.05-14.57 per hour with benefits.

Substitute Bus Driver/Classroom Aide – This position will assist on the bus and in the classroom. Applicants must be 18 years of age, possess a GED or a High School Diploma. If desired, training is available to obtain a CDL to drive the bus. Previous experience with pre-school children would be helpful. This is a 30 hour per week position and the rate of pay is \$10.40. This position is based in Ausable Forks.
